From the Kitchen

Schools have been closed since mid-March, but there's still plenty of work to be done. Nicollet Public Schools, in collaboration with several Nicollet area organizations, has been preparing meals for anyone in the community in need. Weekday meals for children up through age 18 are paid through a federal school lunch program and meals for adults and all weekend meals are paid for by the community.

Meals are prepared in the school kitchen Monday through Friday. All weekend meals are distributed on Fridays. Many meal recipients pick up their meals at the Legion, while others who are elderly, sick, or homebound are able to receive delivery. The kitchen prepares approximately 400 meals per day (and 1200 meals on Friday)! These meals have helped provide some relief to individuals who cannot (or should not) get to a store, adults who are no longer working, people who are working from home, and parents who are now juggling the demands of distance learning.
