The Nicollet Early Childhood Center playground is approaching 20 years old. The outdated equipment has reached the end of its useful life and should be replaced. The old playground is inaccessible to children with physical limitations and does not meet current safety requirements.

Our goal is to build an inclusive playground that stimulates physical, emotional, and social development for children through play. The new surfacing and playground equipment meets the ASTM F1487-21 Playground Equipment for Public Use Standard and will provide a safe, developmentally appropriate play experience for every child.

Nicollet Public School Superintendent Dr. Stephen Malone also expressed support for the playground. "An accessible playground in Nicollet will support the inclusion of many from children who use wheelchairs, walkers or other mobility aids; children with balance issues and gross-motor delays; and students with autism or other sensory processing needs. Furthermore, a modern school playground is vital role in the development of all children. It helps students release energy and provides a mental break during the day, in addition to building fine and gross motor skills, and core strength."

In addition to serving our NECC students, our playground has always and will continue to be available to Nicollet children. The new playground will be a safe space for the children in our community to build friendships, gain confidence and develop physical, social, emotional and imaginative skills. Our fenced in playground has a sign displaying the hours the playground is open to all (weekdays 6 pm-10 pm and all day on holidays and weekends).

Playground Construction is scheduled to begin the spring of 2024. All donations need to be received or pledged by December 1, 2023.


